ORDER

Pursuant to § 2.2-4019, § 2.2-4021, § 54.1-2400(10) and § 54.1-3010 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, (the "Code"), an informal conference was held before a Special Conference Committee of the Board of Nursing (the "Committee") on September 22, 2003, in Henrico County, Virginia, to receive and act upon the application of Erick P. Hutto for licensure by endorsement to practice as a professional nurse in the Commonwealth of Virginia. Mr. Hutto was present and was not represented by counsel.

Upon consideration of the evidence presented, the Committee adopted the following Findings of Facts and Conclusions of Law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. By application received April 9, 2003, Mr. Hutto applied for licensure by endorsement as a professional nurse in the Commonwealth of Virginia.
- 2. On or about February 21, 2003, Mr. Hutto entered into an Order with the Nevada State Board of Nursing, Las Vegas, Nevada, voluntarily surrendering his license to practice as a professional nurse, in lieu of a formal administrative hearing; however, the Nevada State Board of Nursing took no further action.
- 3. Mr. Hutto holds a valid unrestricted professional nurse license in the State of California.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Committee concludes that Mr. Hutto meets the requirements of \S 54.1-3017 and \S 54.1-3018 of the Code.

<u>ORDER</u>

On the basis of the foregoing, the Virginia Board of Nursing, effective upon entry of this Order, hereby ORDERS that the application of Erick P. Hutto for licensure by endorsement as a professional nurse in the Commonwealth of Virginia be and hereby is APPROVED. The Board expects Mr. Hutto, as a licensed professional nurse, to conduct himself in compliance with the requirements of Title 54.1, Chapter 30 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, and the Board of Nursing Regulations.

If Mr. Hutto does not consent to the Committee's decision and desires a hearing before the Board or a panel thereof, she shall notify Jay P. Douglas, R.N., M.S.M., C.S.A.C., Executive Director, Board of Nursing, in writing at 6603 West Broad Street, Fifth Floor, Richmond, Virginia 23230 within thirty-three (33) days from the date of entry of this Order. This Order shall become final upon the expiration of the thirty-three day period unless a request for a formal hearing is received within such time. Upon receiving timely request for a hearing, the Board or a panel thereof shall then proceed with a hearing as provided in § 2.2-4020 and § 2.2-4021 of the Code.
