NOTICE OF HEARING

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4020, 2.2-4024(F), and 54.1-2400(11) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended

("Code"), Christina Lemieux, L.P.N., who, prior to its suspension by the Department of Health Professions

on July 22, 2013, held License No. 0002-030402 to practice practical nursing in Virginia, is hereby given

notice that a formal administrative hearing will be held in the presence of a panel of the Board of Nursing.

The hearing will be held on March 17, 2014, at 11:00 a.m., at the offices of the Department of Health

Professions, Board of Nursing, Perimeter Center, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 201, Henrico, Virginia 23233,

at which time Ms. Lemieux will be afforded the opportunity to be heard in person or by counsel.

At the hearing, Ms. Lemieux has the following rights, among others: the right to representation by

counsel; the right to have witnesses subpoenaed and to present witnesses on her behalf; the right to present

documentary evidence; and the right to cross-examine adverse witnesses. If Ms. Lemieux desires any

witnesses to appear on her behalf, she must notify the Director of Administrative Proceedings, Department of

Health Professions, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 300, Henrico, Virginia 23233, in accordance with the

Instructions for Requesting Subpoenas.

The purpose of the hearing is to receive and act upon Ms. Lemieux's application for reinstatement of

her license to practice practical nursing in Virginia, which was mandatorily suspended by the Department of

Health Professions on July 22, 2013, and to inquire into evidence that Ms. Lemieux may have violated

certain laws governing practical nursing practice in Virginia, as more fully set forth in the Statement of

Particulars below.

The burden rests upon Ms. Lemieux, as the applicant, to demonstrate that she is capable of resuming the

safe and competent practice of nursing in Virginia.

Pursuant to § 54.1-2409 of the Code, reinstatement of Ms. Lemieux's license requires the affirmative vote

of three-fourths of the members of the Board in attendance at the hearing.

STATEMENT OF PARTICULARS

The Board alleges that:

1. Christina Lemieux may have violated § 54.1-3007(4) of the Code in that on or about January

28, 2013, she was convicted of one count of attempted obtaining money or property by false pretenses and

one count of obtaining money or property by false pretenses, both felonies, in the Circuit Court for the City

of Virginia Beach, Virginia, and was sentenced by an Order entered on May 28, 2013. Said convictions

formed the basis for the mandatory suspension of her license to practice practical nursing by the Department

of Health Professions.

2. Ms. Lemieux may have violated § 54.1-3007(6) of the Code in that on or about April 2, 2010,

she was convicted of driving while intoxicated, a misdemeanor, in the General District Court for the City of

Virginia Beach, Virginia.
