**NOTICE OF HEARING**

Henrico, Virginia 23233, at which time Ms. Waite will be afforded the opportunity to be heard in person or

by counsel.

At the hearing, Ms. Waite has the following rights, among others: the right to representation by

counsel; the right to have witnesses subpoenaed and to present witnesses on her behalf; the right to present

documentary evidence; and the right to cross-examine adverse witnesses. If Ms. Waite desires any witnesses

to appear on her behalf, she must notify the Director of Administrative Proceedings, Department of Health

Professions, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 300, Henrico, Virginia 23233, in accordance with the Instructions

for Requesting Subpoenas.

The purpose of the hearing is to inquire into evidence that Sarah Cleveland Waite, R.N. may have

violated certain terms and conditions imposed on her as set forth in the Consent Order of the Board entered

on July 17, 2013 ("Board's Order"), as more fully set forth in the Statement of Particulars below.

## STATEMENT OF PARTICULARS

The Board alleges that Sarah Cleveland Waite, R.N., may have violated Term No. 5 of the Board's Order which stayed the indefinite suspension of her license contingent upon her compliance with all the terms and conditions of the Health Practitioners Monitoring Program ("HPMP"). On March 21, 2014, Ms. Waite was dismissed from the HPMP for noncompliance in that she failed to maintain compliance with the toxicology screening program and she resigned from the HPMP while in a warning status.
