NOTICE OF HEARING

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4020, 2.2-4024(F), and 54.1-2400(11) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended (“Code”), Kristi Broyles, L.P.N., who, prior to its suspension by the Board of Nursing on October 16, 2013, held License No. 0002-060811 to practice practical nursing in Virginia, is hereby given notice that a formal administrative hearing will be held in the presence of a panel of the Board of Nursing. The hearing will be held on January 29, 2014, at 1:00 p.m., at the offices of the Department of Health Professions, Board of Nursing, Perimeter Center, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 201, Henrico, Virginia 23233, at which time Ms. Broyles will be afforded the opportunity to be heard in person or by counsel.


At the hearing, Ms. Broyles has the following rights, among others: the right to representation by counsel; the right to have witnesses subpoenaed and to present witnesses on her behalf; the right to present documentary evidence; and the right to cross-examine adverse witnesses. If Ms. Broyles desires any witnesses to appear on her behalf, she must notify the Director of Administrative Proceedings, Department of Health Professions, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 300, Henrico, Virginia 23233, in accordance with the Instructions for Requesting Subpoenas.

The purpose of the hearing is to inquire into evidence that Ms. Broyles may have violated certain laws governing the practice of practical nursing and terms and conditions imposed on her as set forth in the Order of the Board entered on July 17, 2013, as more fully set forth in the Statement of Particulars below.

STATEMENT OF PARTICULARS

The Board alleges that Krista Broyles, L.P.N., may have violated § 54.1-3007 (6) of the Code and Term 5(a) of the Order of the Board entered July 17, 2013, which required her to comply with all terms and conditions specified by the Health Practitioners' Monitoring Program ("HPMP"), in that on or about September 5, 2013, Ms. Broyles resigned from the HPMP.
