ORDER

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4019, 2.2-4021, and 54.1-2400(10) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended (“Code”), a Special Conference Committee (“Committee”) of the Virginia Board of Nursing (“Board”) met on February 11, 2013, in Henrico County, Virginia, to receive and act upon Prisca I. Muotoh’s application for reinstatement of her license to practice practical nursing in Virginia. Ms. Muotoh was present and was not represented by counsel. Upon consideration of the evidence, the Committee adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Prisca I. Muotoh, L.P.N., was issued License No. 0002-072540 to practice practical nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia on November 2, 2005. Said license was suspended by Order of the Board entered on June 8, 2010. Ms. Muotoh’s primary state of residence is Virginia.
2. By letter dated January 15, 2013, the Board of Nursing sent a Notice of Informal Conference (“Notice”) to Ms. Muotoh notifying her that an informal conference would be held on February 11, 2013. The Notice was sent by certified and first class mail to 3329 Southgate Drive, # 8, Alexandria, Virginia 22306, the address of record on file with the Board of Nursing.
3. Ms. Muotoh provided evidence of completing 15 hours of continuing education, with five hours in documentation, and several letters of support.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Board concludes that Ms. Muotoh has demonstrated satisfactory evidence that she is prepared to resume practice in a safe and competent manner.

ORDER

On the basis of the foregoing, the Committee hereby ORDERS as follows:

1. The application of Prisca I. Muotoh for reinstatement of her license to practice practical nursing is hereby APPROVED.

2. Within 60 days of entry of this Order, Ms. Muotoh shall enroll in a Board-approved refresher course. Ms. Muotoh shall not practice until she has provided written evidence to the Board of satisfactory completion of said courses and has received permission from the Board to do so.

3. Ms. Muotoh shall maintain a course of conduct in her capacity as a practical nurse commensurate with the requirements of § 54.1-3000 *et seq.* of the Code and the Board of Nursing Regulations.


4. Any violation of the terms and conditions of this Order or of any law or regulation affecting the practice of nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia shall constitute grounds for the suspension or revocation of the license of Ms. Muotoh and an administrative proceeding shall be convened to determine whether such license shall be suspended or revoked.

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as public record and shall be made available for public inspection or copying on request.

Pursuant to Section 54.1-2400(10) of the Code, Ms. Muotoh may, not later than 5:00 p.m., on **April 2, 2013**, notify Jay P. Douglas, Executive Director, Board of Nursing, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 300,

Henrico, Virginia 23233, in writing that she desires a formal administrative hearing before the Board. Upon the filing with the Executive Director of a request for the hearing, this Order shall be vacated.


