CONSENT ORDER

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") and Ashley Beverly, as evidenced by her signature hereto, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Ms. Beverly's application for certification by examination as a nurse aide in Virginia.

The Board adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Ashley Beverly submitted an application for certification by examination as a nurse aide in Virginia, which was received by the Board on May 8, 2013.
2. On December 4, 2006, Ms. Beverly was convicted in the Circuit Court of Rockbridge County, Virginia, of possession of cocaine, a felony.
3. As a result of the conviction, Ms. Beverly was placed on supervised probation, from which she was released on October 18, 2010. She was then placed on unsupervised probation until December 4, 2010.
4. In a letter to the Board dated May 7, 2013, Ms. Beverly stated that she maintains her sobriety with the assistance of therapy, counseling and support groups. She stated she does "my best to attend NA meetings around my area once a month." Ms. Beverly also enclosed a positive letter of reference from the family member of an Alzheimer's patient that she cared for from June 2012 until the individual's death in January 2013.
5. Ms. Beverly is currently employed with Heritage Hall.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

Finding of Fact No. 2 constitutes a violation of § 54.1-3007(4) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended (“Code”).

CONSENT

Ashley Beverly, by affixing her signature hereon, agrees to the following:

1. She has been advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document;
2. She acknowledges that without her consent, no legal action can be taken against her except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, § 2.2-4000(A) *et seq.* of the Code;
3. She acknowledges that she has the following rights, among others: the right to an informal fact finding conference before the Board, the right to reasonable notice of said hearing, the right to representation by counsel, and the right to cross-examine witnesses against her;
4. She waives all such right to an informal conference;
5. She admits to the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law contained herein and waives her right to contest such Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in any subsequent proceeding before the Board;
6. She consents to the entry of the following Order affecting her application for certification by examination as a nurse aide in Virginia.

ORDER

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, the Virginia Board of Nursing, effective upon entry of this Order, and in lieu of further proceedings, hereby ORDERS as follows:

1. The application of Ashley Beverly for licensure certification by examination as a nurse aide is APPROVED. Upon successful completion of the NNAAP examination, Ms. Beverly shall be issued an unrestricted certificate to practice as a nurse aide in the Commonwealth.

2. Ms. Beverly is hereby REPRIMANDED.

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as public record and shall be made available for public inspection or copying upon request.
