CONSENT ORDER

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") and Alleen M. Nance, C.N.A., as evidenced by her signature hereto, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Ms. Nance's certificate to practice as a nurse aide in Virginia.

The Board adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Alleen M. Nance a.k.a. Alleen M. Eleazer, C.N.A. was issued Certificate No. 1401-077437 to practice as a nurse aide by the Virginia Board of Nursing on April 21, 1999. Said certificate is set to expire on April 30, 2014.
- 2. During the course of her employment as a nurse aide at Chesapeake Health and Rehabilitation Center, Chesapeake, Virginia, on March 4, 2013, Ms. Nance was performing care on a resident. The resident's care plan required two persons to attend to the resident when turning the resident over. When Ms. Nance attempted to turn the resident over unassisted, the resident slipped out of bed and fell to the floor, resulting in the resident receiving a bruise and complaining of pain in the back, neck and right side. As a result, Ms. Nance was terminated from her employment.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Board finds that Finding of Fact No. 2 constitutes a violation of § 54.1-3007(5) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code").

CONSENT

Alleen M. Nance, C.N.A., by affixing her signature hereon, agrees to the following:

- 1. She has been advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document;
- 2. She acknowledges that without her consent, no legal action can be taken against her except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, § 2.2-4000(A) et seq. of the Code;
- 3. She acknowledges that she has the following rights, among others: the right to an informal fact finding conference before the Board, the right to reasonable notice of said hearing, the right to representation by counsel, and the right to cross-examine witnesses against her;
 - 4. She waives all such right to an informal conference;
- 5. She admits to the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law contained herein and waives her right to contest such Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in any subsequent proceeding before the Board;
- 6. She consents to the entry of the following Order affecting her right to practice as a nurse aide in Virginia.

ORDER

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, the Virginia Board of Nursing, effective upon entry of this Order, and in lieu of further proceedings, hereby ORDERS as follows:

- 1. Alleen M. Nance, C.N.A., is hereby REPRIMANDED.
- 2. Ms. Nance shall maintain a course of conduct in her capacity as a nurse aide commensurate with the requirements of § 54.1-3000 et seq. of the Code and the Board of Nursing Regulations.

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as public record and shall be made available for public inspection or copying upon request.
