CONSENT ORDER

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") and Christina Gillaspay, as evidenced by her signature hereto, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Ms. Gillaspay's application for reinstatement of her certification to practice as a massage therapist in Virginia.

The Board adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Christina Gillaspay was issued Certificate No. 0019-005607 to practice as a massage therapist by the Virginia Board of Nursing on October 6, 2005. Said certificate expired on June 30, 2007.
2. Ms. Gillaspay submitted an application for reinstatement of her certificate, which was received by the Board on March 26, 2013.
3. On February 24, 2011, Ms. Gillaspay was convicted of conceal/price alter merchandise of a value of less than \$200.00 in the Rockingham/Harrisonburg, Virginia, General District Court.
4. Ms. Gillaspay paid the fine and costs associated with the above conviction.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Finding of Fact No. 3 constitutes a violation of § 54.1-3007(4) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code").
2. Ms. Gillaspay otherwise meets the requirements for reinstatement of her certificate to practice as a massage therapist.

CONSENT

Christina Gillaspy, by affixing her signature hereon, agrees to the following:

1. She has been advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document;
2. She acknowledges that without her consent, no legal action can be taken against her except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, § 2.2-4000(A) *et seq.* of the Code;
3. She acknowledges that she has the following rights, among others: the right to an informal fact finding conference before the Board, the right to reasonable notice of said hearing, the right to representation by counsel, and the right to cross-examine witnesses against her;
4. She waives all such right to an informal conference;
5. She admits to the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law contained herein and waives her right to contest such Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in any subsequent proceeding before the Board;
6. She consents to the entry of the following Order affecting her application for reinstatement of her certification to practice as a massage therapist in Virginia.

ORDER


WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, the Virginia Board of Nursing, effective upon entry of this Order, and in lieu of further proceedings, hereby ORDERS as follows:

1. The application of Christina Gillaspy for reinstatement of her certificate to practice as a massage therapist in the Commonwealth of Virginia is hereby APPROVED. Ms. Gillaspy shall be issued an unrestricted certificate.
2. Ms. Gillaspy is hereby REPRIMANDED.

3. Ms. Gillaspy shall maintain a course of conduct in her capacity as a massage therapist commensurate with the requirements of § 54.1-3000 *et seq.* of the Code and the Board of Nursing Regulations.

Pursuant to § 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as a public record, and shall be made available for public inspection and copying upon request.


