#### **NOTICE OF HEARING**

Pursuant to § 2.2-4020, § 2.2-4021, § 54.1-110, and § 54.1-2400(11) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, Julia K. Cash, R.N., is hereby given notice that, pursuant to § 2.2-4024(F), a formal administrative hearing will be held in the presence of a panel of the Board of Nursing ("the Board"). The hearing will be held on March 19, 2003, at 10:30 a.m., at the offices of the Department of Health Professions, 6603 West Broad Street, Fifth Floor, Richmond, Virginia, at which time Ms. Cash will be afforded the opportunity to be heard in person or by counsel.

At the hearing Ms. Cash has the following rights, among others: the right to representation by counsel, the right to have witnesses subpoenaed and to present witnesses on her behalf, the right to present documentary evidence and the right to cross-examine adverse witnesses. If Ms. Cash desires any witnesses to appear on her behalf, she must notify the Director of the Administrative Proceedings Division, 6603 West Broad Street, Richmond, Virginia 23230-1717, giving the names and address of the witnesses, at least fifteen (15) days prior to the date of the hearing in order that subpoenas may be issued.

The purpose of the hearing is to receive and act upon evidence that Ms. Cash may have violated an Order of the Board entered February 14, 2002, and certain laws and regulations governing the practice of nursing in Virginia, as more fully set forth in the Statement of Particulars below.

### STATEMENT OF PARTICULARS

The Board alleges that:

1. Julia K. Cash, R.N., holds License No. 0001-143044, issued by the Virginia Board of Nursing, which expired December 31, 2002, due to her failure to renew.

- 2. Ms. Cash may have violated Term Number 1 of an Order of the Board entered February 14, 2002, and § 54.1-3007(2) and (6) of the Code, in that: On or about March 7, 2002, she verbally stated that she was not going to continue in the program as ordered. On or about April 19, 2002, she was dismissed from the HPIP for failing to:
  - a) Return a signed Recovery Monitoring Contract;
  - b) Attend 12-step and/or Caduceus meetings;
  - c) Call for or submit to urine drug screens since December 28, 2001;
  - d) Respond to telephone messages and written correspondence regarding her non-compliance; and
  - e) Submit monthly self-reports.
