STATEMENT OF PARTICULARS

The Board alleges that Reva G. Neel, R.N., may have violated Term No. 5 of the Board's Order which required her to enter into and comply with all terms and conditions of the Health Practitioners' Monitoring Program ("HPMP") in that, on or about January 11, 2013, Ms. Neel was dismissed from the HPMP due to noncompliance. Specifically, Ms. Neel failed to attend or reschedule HPMP orientation, register for the urine toxicology screening program and maintain contact with her case manager. Further, on or about October 21, 2012, Ms. Neel submitted a letter of resignation to the HPMP.
