CONSENT ORDER FOR VOLUNTARY SURRENDER OF LICENSE


Kristen Graham ("Respondent") is licensed as a Registered Nurse by the Rhode Island Board of Nurse Registration and Nursing Education ("Board") within the Rhode Island Department of Health ("HEALTH") and holds License No. RN35008. Complaints identified as case #C14-0328 and #C16-096 have been filed with the Board against Respondent's Rhode Island Registered Nurse license, pursuant to Rhode Island Gen. Laws § § 5-34-25. In resolution of said complaints, Respondent and the Board do hereby stipulate and agree to the following:

1. Respondent admits to the jurisdiction of the Board and agrees to waive further procedural steps before an administrative hearing officer and any right to appeal this Consent Order.
2. Respondent **VOLUNTARILY SURRENDERS** her license as a Registered Nurse for an indefinite period but for at least six (6) consecutive months, commencing with the date on which the Board signs and ratifies this Consent Order ("Effective Date").
3. This surrender of Respondent's license shall continue until such time as Respondent successfully applies for reinstatement by the Board.
4. After the Effective Date of this Consent Order and at such time as when Respondent wishes to apply for the reinstatement of her Registered Nurse license, she must complete to the satisfaction of the Board all of the requirements set forth in **EXHIBIT A**, (a non-public document to be maintained by the Board).


5. This Consent Order constitutes a final disposition of case #C14-0328 and case #C16-096.
