**CONSENT ORDER FOR REPRIMAND** 

Pursuant to Section 14.1 of the Rules and Regulations Pertaining to the Practices and

Procedures Before the Rhode Island Department of Health, the Board of Nurse Registration and

Nursing Education ("Board") and Robin Fox ("Respondent"), a registered nurse (RN) who is

licensed by the Board, agree to resolve the above-referenced complaint against her license by

entering into this Consent Order for Reprimand. Respondent and the Board further agree that

this Consent Order is enforceable as a final Order of the Board.

Wishing to resolve this matter without an administrative hearing, Respondent admits to

the jurisdiction of the Board and agrees to waive further procedural steps and any right to appeal

this Consent Order. Respondent admits that the following Findings of Fact are true and that the

Conclusions of Law are correct.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

1. Respondent is licensed to practice as a registered nurse in the State of Rhode Island under

license RN49400.

2. Pursuant to Rhode Island Gen. Laws § 5-34-25 of the Rhode Island General Laws, this matter was opened upon the Board's receipt of a complaint against Respondent's license,

case no. C17-0239 (the "Complaint"), alleging that Respondent had had an inappropriate

relationship with a patient.

3. While Respondent was employed as a Home Health Nurse for Addiction Recovery

Institute, located in Pawtucket, Rhode Island, she did, in fact, develop an inappropriate

relationship with a client in her care.

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## CONCLUSION OF LAW:

4. The conduct described in paragraph three (3) constitutes unprofessional conduct as defined in Rhode Island Gen. Laws § 5-34-24(6).

Whereas Respondent wishes and agrees to voluntarily enter into this Consent Order for a Reprimand against her license, and whereas the Board finds the within disposition adequately protective of the public health, safety, and welfare, and for good cause shown,

## IT IS THEREFORE AGREED AND ORDERED:

- 1. Respondent is hereby issued the sanction of a Reprimand.
- 2. This Consent Order shall become part of a public record of this proceeding.
- 3. This Consent Order shall be effective upon its execution by both Respondent and the Board.
- 4. This Consent Order shall obviate the necessity for an administrative hearing on the above-referenced Complaint and constitute a final disposition of the Complaint.
